

The Honor Oak Stream



Hilly Fields Park

The Honor Oak Stream passes through two underground pipes before it reaches the River Ravensbourne. The watercourse floods when water cannot reach the River Ravensbourne quick enough.

We are considering two options to reduce this risk. Either:

- Re-landscape Ladywell Green to create a flood storage area, or
- Pump additional water to the River Ravensbourne during extreme rainfall incidents.

Our option to provide flood storage at Ladywell Green would provide an opportunity to enhance the park's recreation facilities, whilst keeping floodwater away from homes and businesses.

We would re-landscape the park, lowering ground levels by up to 1.5 metres (5 foot).



Our alternative option would mean fitting a pump to the existing outfall in Ladywell Fields, near the end of Malyns Road. This would be done at the same time as undertaking the proposed wall raising work at this site.

The pump would only operate in extreme rainfall incidents.
