Dear John,

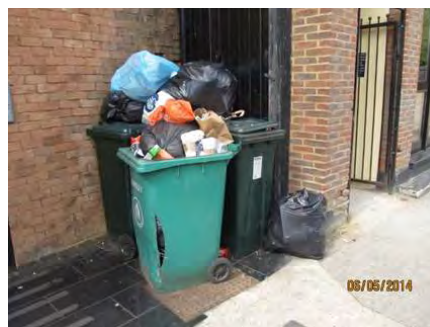
See below – I hardly need to add anything do I?

RESULT: we did get a substantial and considered reply from John Bosley. The main problem is that the flats backing on to Walters Yard have no external storage area for their refuse. This means that they are forced to leave plastic bags by the roadside waiting collection by the refuse crews. While there, it is easy foxes to attack them making a mess. Various solutions have been tried but unfortunately there does not seem much that can be done
